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FSAFEDS FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNTS

A flexible spending account is a pretax benefit account that's used to pay for eligible medical, dental and vision care expenses that are not covered by your health care plan or elsewhere.

Mail to: Office of Personnel Management, P.O. Box 5000, Lawrence, KS 66046-0500

If using mail, clearly state your Open Season request. If you are making an enrollment change, tell OPM the plan you want, the type of coverage and the enrollment code. Remember to include your annuity claim number and Social Security Number on your request. If you are choosing Self Plus One or Self and Family coverage, OPM will also need your eligible family member's information and other insurance information as specified in the instructions mailed to you at the beginning of Open Season. Mail must be postmarked no later than December 9, 2019.






